The Dallam Hartley Counties Healthcare Foundation supports the Dallam Hartley Counties Hospital District healthcare services by advocating for healthcare services and raising funds to enhance programs, equipment, scholarships and facilities in Dallam and Hartley Counties.

The Foundation's goal for awarding scholarships: To encourage and support students who want to become qualified healthcare employees of the Dallam Hartley Counties Hospital District.

Application Deadline: Fri, March 26, 2021. Noon

Requirements of applicants:

- Applicant must fall into one of these categories:
 - Must be a graduating senior from Dalhart, Hartley, Channing, or Texline High Schools or homeschooled in Dallam or Hartley County; Must have at least a "B" (3.0 GPA) average and your official transcript is required with your application
 - or
 - Must have a high school diploma, be employed by the DHC Hospital District and desire education to promote-up to a higher position; Must have at least a "B" (3.0 GPA) average on HS diploma and your official transcript is required with your application
 - or
 - Must have a high school diploma, reside in Dallam or Hartley County; want to attain a medical degree, certificate, license, etc. in order to become employed at the DHC Hospital District; Must have at least a "B" (3.0 GPA) average on HS diploma and your official transcript is required with your application
- Must be planning a healthcare career and enrolling in studies toward such a degree. The scholarship award will fund a degree range up to a bachelor's degree.
- The scholarship recipient must sign a commitment to be employed in the Dallam Hartley Counties Hospital District for a minimum of 6-months.
- Must plan to enroll in 12 hours during the fall 2021 and spring 2022 semesters
- Depending on covid restrictions in the spring, the selected scholarship winners may possibly be asked to complete 8 hours volunteer work in the DHCHD in order to meet the final criteria and to be assure the scholarship payment will be mailed to your college. - Scholarships are paid directly to your college account prior to the semester beginning.

- Incomplete applications will not be considered. Failure to provide the required attachments will disqualify the applicant.

Attachments required:

- Completed application
- Official high school transcript, sealed, is required whether just graduating or a former high school graduate
- Two letters of recommendation from a teacher, counselor, principal, church leader, employer, 4-H or FFA club leader, or any other leadership person in your life.
