# — Our Year in Review



We awarded scholarships to **6** high school graduates and **3** current LVNs at DHCHD who are working to attain **RN** certification.

The Foundation established the Dr. Cunningham Scholarship in 2019, which provides financial assistance to train and equip our future and existing health workforce.

*\$15.000* given by Hilmar and donors in The Panhandle Gives Campaign for a mini PT/OT gym in the hospital, convenient for both nursing home patients and swing bed patients.

We partner with the Hospital District, under a shared goal to advance services offered and upgrade equipment.

Since October 2021, **19**() women have been screened for breast cancer, thanks to the Harrington Cancer & Health Foundation grant that brought mammography services to Dalhart.

We seek to connect our Hospital District with philanthropic efforts, allowing for greater impact locally.

**The Pearl Ingram Estate** left a bequest of \$150,000, which the Foundation Board designated toward the new **90** patient room nursing home.

With gifts like this and the support from our community, we are pleased to envision a legacy of health and care for aenerations to come.

**\$7245** earned in amplification dollars through The Panhandle Gives campaign. Donors designated \$56,206 for the Dallam Hartley County Healthcare Foundation during the campaign, earning the extra amplification funding.
